## **Biblical Parenting Workshop with Brent Donoho**

Do you find yourself spinning your wheels trying to get your children to listen to you? Do you feel guilty because you have had to spank your child for disrespecting you or defying your authority when the world says not to do it? Do you feel inadequate or burned out as a parent?

On October 20-22, Brent Donoho will present to us a Biblical Parenting Workshop. He will help us dig into the Scriptures to see what God says about parenting. The goal of this workshop is not to make parents feel ashamed or guilty about their parental tactics, but it is to encourage them. There is no shame in seeking God's help to be the best we can be, by His grace, for the ones who did not ask to be born. Your attendance is commendable; we are all in this together.

In the first session, Brent will explore the goals of God-centered parenting, which is so different from the parenting we see around us. However, Biblical parenting still needs clearly defined goals. What does God want us to accomplish as we raise the children He has blessed us with?

The next two sessions will delve into the strategies of accomplishing that goal. These strategies will focus on the molding of the heart and character of our children into the heart of God. The last two sessions will focus on how the parents can meet that objective with proper teaching and discipline.

If you are not a parent, I personally encourage you to attend anyway. Perhaps you are a Bible class teacher, a coach or a mentor in a civic organization focused on youth, you have more influence on children than you might think. Are you a widow(er) who would like to "adopt" a "grandchild" in the church to mentor? Paul and Timothy understood the concept of "spiritual" mothers and fathers in the church (1 Timothy 5:1-2). Remember also, the One who had the greatest influence on children had no biological children of His own.

Whether you are a parent, a prospective parent, a grandparent, a Bible class teacher, a coach, a mentor or a "spiritual" mother or father, I hope to see you there on October 20-22.
